HYSBYSIR DRWY HYN fod Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Blaenau Gwent yn cynnig yn unol â Rheoliadau Gorchymyn Traffig Awdurdodau Lleol (Gweithdrefn) (Lloegr a Chymru) 1996 a Deddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984 (y cyfeirir ati o hyn ymlaen fel "y Ddeddf"), fel y'i diwygiwyd a Rhan IV Atodlen 9 y Ddeddf, a Deddf Rheoli Traffig 2004 (Deddf '2004') a'r holl bwerau galluogi eraill a fydd â'r effaith o:

- Cyflwyno baeau parcio Cerbydau Trydan o fewn y Safleoedd Tacsî dynodedig a enwyd, sef:
- Safle Tacsî yn Heol yr Orsaf, Brynmawr.
- Safle Tacsî yng Nglynebwy gyda mynediad o'r A4046.

Medrir gweld y drafft Orchymyn Rheoleiddio Traffig Seiliedig ar Fap a'r Datganiad Rhesymau ar-lein ar wefan Cyngor Blaenau Gwent.

Mae'r Cyngor yn cynnig gwneud Gorchymyn Diwygio Rhif 4 fydd â'r effaith gyffredinol o ddiwygio Gorchymyn Cydgrynhoi Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Blaenau Gwent (Gwahardd a Chyfyngu Aros a Llwytho a Mannau Parcio Ar y Stryd) 2019 ("y Gorchymyn Cydgrynhoi") i sicrhau defnydd diogel ac effeithiol o'r rhwydwaith priffyrdd.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council propose that in accordance with the Local Authorities Traffic Order (Procedure) (England & Wales) Regulations 1996 and the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), as amended, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and The Traffic Management Act 2004 (the '2004'Act) and all other enabling powers the effect of which will be:

- To introduce Electric Vehicle parking bays within the designated named Taxi Ranks, namely:
- Taxi Rank at Brynmawr at Station Road.
- Taxi Rank at Ebbw Vale accessed off the A4046.

The draft Map – Based Traffic Regulation Order and Statement of Reasons can be viewed online on Blaenau Gwent Council's website.

The Council proposes to make Amendment Order No.4 which shall have the general effect of amending the Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and On-Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2019 ("the Consolidation Order") to ensure the safe and efficient use of the highway network.

If you wish to object to the proposals you will need to send the grounds for objection in writing to the Head of Community Services, so as to be received by 11th November 2021. Any objection received after that date will not be considered.
