| MA18.2 | Paragraph 8.86 | Amend paragraph 8.86 as follows: Land adjacent to the existing Trefil Quarry has been identified as an area of known mineral resource with commercial potential. The resource may provide for a continuous supply for use as building stone and in making concrete. Development of the site is dependent on the ability to address a number of environmental concerns. The most significant issue being the identification of the area as part of a nationally important geological SSSI at Mynydd Llangynidr which contains the finest array of collapse (caprock) dolines and subsidence basins seen anywhere in Britain. |
