RHODDIR HYSBYSIAD DRWY HYN fod Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Blaenau Gwent, yn unol â Rheoliadau Gorchymynion Traffig Awurdodau Lleol (Gweithdrefn) (Cymru a Lloegr) 1996 a Deddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984 (y cyfeirir ati yma wedi hyn fel "y Ddeddf"), fel y diwygiwyd, a Rhan IV o Atodlen 9 i'r Ddeddf, a Deddf Rheoli Traffig 2004 ("Deddf 2004") a phob pŵer galluogi arall, ac ar ôl ymgynghori â Phrif Swyddog yr Heddlu, yn cynnig gwneud y gorchymyn uchod a diwygio'r cyfyngiadau ar y ffyrdd canlynol fel yr amlinellir isod ac yn yr atodlen.

- Mae'r cyngor yn cynnig gwneud Gorchymyn Diwygio Rhif 17, a fydd yn cael yr effaith gyffredinol o ddiwygio Gorchymyn Cydgrynhoi Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Blaenau Gwent (Gwahardd a Chyfyngu ar Aros a Llwytho a Mannau Parcio ar y Stryd) 2019 ("y Gorchymyn Cydgrynhoi") er mwyn sicrhau defnydd diogel ac effeithlon o'r rhwydwaith priffyrdd.
- Effeithiau'r gorchymyn fydd:
 - Cyflwyno marciau Ysgol Cadwch yn Glir ar hyd Stryd y Llwyfen, Cwm, fel y dangosir ar y daflen fap â chyfeirnod R37A.

Mae manylion llawn y cynigion hyn yn y gorchymyn drafft, sydd, ynghyd â chynllun yn dangos yr ardal gyfyngedig a datganiad o resymau'r cyngor dros gynnig gwneud y gorchymyn, ar gael ar wefan Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Blaenau Gwent, ac y byddant felly tan y dyddiad dod i ben o 21 diwrnod o ddyddiad cyhoeddi'r hysbysiad hwn.

**(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING
AND LOADING AND ON-STREET PARKING
PLACES (CIVIL PARKING ENFORCEMENT AND
CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2019 (AMENDMENT NO. 17))**

ROAD AND TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council propose that in accordance with the Local Authorities Traffic Order (Procedure) (England & Wales) Regulations 1996 and the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), as amended, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and The Traffic Management Act 2004 (the '2004 Act') and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, to make the above Order, and to amend the restrictions on the following roads as outlined below and in the schedule.

- The Council proposes to make Amendment Order No.17 which shall have the general effect of amending the Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and On-Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2019 ("the Consolidation Order") to ensure the safe and efficient use of the highway network.
- The effects of the Order will be to:
 - Introduce School Keep Clear along Elm Street, Cwm as shown on map sheet reference R37A.

Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which, together with a plan showing the restricted area and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order are available on the Blaenau Gwent County Borough Council website and will be so until the expiration date of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 5 December 2024.
